



Uniform Policy

YUNA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The Yuna Primary School Uniform Policy has been developed to support the values of pride and respect for the school, ourselves and others. The wider community judges the whole school on how individuals behave therefore students should take care to dress and act appropriately.

UNIFORMS

Uniforms in the school colours are to be worn. Girls and boys may choose from those listed. Appropriate school clothing on the top and bottom is required.

- Green/yellow school shirt
- Skirts, skorts, shorts or tracksuit pants in school colour
- Green broad brimmed school hat
- Closed in shoes or firmly fitting sandals. Black joggers-black socks, coloured joggers-white sock. Coloured trim permitted.
- School or green windcheater, jumper

HATS

School hats must be worn on the head when in the playground and on excursions where exposure to the sun is unavoidable. For health and safety reasons the 'No Hat, No Sun' rules apply to ALL students who do not have their school hat. These students can only play in the undercover area during recess and lunch until their hat can be worn.

SWIMMING

Students are to wear well fitting, appropriate bathers for all swimming lessons. This includes a rashie plus a full piece or bikini (girls) and / or bather shorts (boys). Students must also provide a towel and thongs (to walk to and from the pool) for all swimming lessons.

FOOTWEAR

Footwear should either be closed in shoes or firmly fitting sandals. For safety reasons it is not considered appropriate for students to wear scuffs or floppy sandals at school. Thongs are necessary when walking to and from the swimming pool and only permitted during Terms 1 and 4.

JEWELLERY

Students wearing jewellery which is considered to pose a safety risk will be asked to remove the said piece.

HAIR

If hair is long, and/or in the eyes, it is to be tied back off the face and collar. This applies to both girls and boys.
