Bushfire Preparedness

The bushfire season is once again upon us. Our school has a Bushfire Zone register of "very high". If a fire behaviour index of 75 or greater is forecast, we may be directed to follow the process for pre-emptive closure.

The decision on whether or not our school will go ahead with the planned closure will be made by 4:30 pm the day before. If the forecast changes after the 4:30 pm deadline, the school will remain closed.

Parents will be notified individually by phone and information will be posted on the school's Facebook Page.

Staff and students will be undertaking several practise drills throughout the remainder of Term 3 and during Term 4.

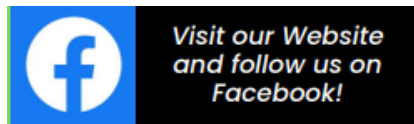
